THE IMPORTANCE OF INSTITUTIONS INTERACTION REDUCING ROAD TRAFICKING ACCIDENTS, IN ALBANIA

ABSTRACT

Road trafficking accidents have relatively high mortality and are economic and social problem, not only for state police, but also and for health and education systems. Materials and Methods: Road trafficking accidents that occurred in Tirana, during the last 10 years 2013-2022, referred to the State Police. Results: Mortality from accidents varies from 4 to 7.5%. There is a decrease in accidents during the pandemic years. 5.2% of the people who had an accident were under the influence of alcohol. Hit and run were 6.6%. The greatest number of accidents is observed to be during the rush hours 8-12.00. Conclusions: Accidents are more and more disturbing problem especially in urban life. Mortality from accidents is at the top of the mortality list together with cancer and cardiovascular diseases. Reducing accidents and monitoring them is not only the duty of the state police, but also the obligation of public health, medical teams including forensic doctors, but also the obligation of educational institutions from an early age, where the individual must be first educated to the culture of law and the core of a good citizen.
